Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst.ID AYU0083) with intake capacity of UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats & 20 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely (1) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (2) Kayachikitsa - 05 seats (3) Panchakarma - 05 seats (4) Shalya Tantra - 05 seats course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Bagamar Seva Samiti's Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Gajendergad Tq. Ron, Distt. Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst.ID AYU0083) inspection of your College was conducted on 05.06.2023 & 06.06.2023 and revisited on 30.06.2023 & 01.07.2023 on hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Asessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) & 20 Seats in 04 PG course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- 3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the 58th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 14.09.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuance of Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course & 20 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely (1) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (2) Kayachikitsa 05 seats (3) Panchakarma 05 seats (4) Shalya 05 seats course for the academic session 2023-24 and Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college. Accordingly, the hearing was conducted on 20.09.2023 to present the case through virtual mode.
- 4. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 61st Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 26.09.2023. Board verified the same and and decided to issue Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course & 20 Seats in 04 PG

Courses namely (1) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (2) Kayachikitsa - 05 seats (3) Panchakarma - 05 seats (4) Shalya - 05 seats course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 with a warning, for the academic session 2023-24.

- 5. Meanwhile, a monetary penalty was imposed on your college in respect of appointing physically absent but present only on paper teachers, vide letter ref no. **Teacher Verification/ MARB/2023 dated 28.08.2023**.
- 6. Further, your college had filed an appeal before the Chairman and the appeal is under process at the level of the Commission. Looking to the urgency involved in the matter, owing to the ongoing admission process, the Commission Stayed the order passed by Medical Assessment and Rating Board vide letter ref no. Teacher Verification/ MARB/2023 dated 28.08.2023 to the extent of penalty imposed by Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine and further directed the Board to issue the necessary permission to the college as per rules vide letter ref no. NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2023-24)-(Karnataka) dated 10.10.2023.
- 7. Furthermore, the college was assessed without considering the teachers who were physically absent but present only on paper and the college was fulfilling the basic criteria for conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course & 20 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely (1) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana 05 seats (2) Kayachikitsa 05 seats (3) Panchakarma 05 seats (4) Shalya 05 seats course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 8. Therefore, Conditional Permission is granted to Bagamar Seva Samiti's Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Gajendergad Tq. Ron, Distt. Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst.ID AYU0083) 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course & 20 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely (1) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (2) Kayachikitsa 05 seats (3) Panchakarma 05 seats (4) Shalya 05 seats course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 along with warning to fulfill the below mentioned requirements and subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

A. Requirements:-

- a) Maintain the average attendance of OPD per day as regulation 7 of MSR 2016.
- b) Maintain the OPD registers as per regulation 7 of MSR 2016.
- c) Maintain regular attendance of PG students

B. Conditions:-

- The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 20 Seats in 04 PG Courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 10. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 11. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 12. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25: -
 - i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda).

- iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; &
- iv) all the requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post graduate Education) Regulations, 2016;
- (A) Requirements mentioned in point no.7(A) above.
- 13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
- 14. The decision mentioned in this letter is subject to the final outcome of the appeal under process at the level of Commission.
- 15. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
