Subject:-Grant of Conditional Permission to Bagamar Seva Samiti's Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Gajendergad Tq. Ron, Distt. Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0083) with 60 seats in UG BAMS Course and 20 Seats of PG Course in 04 subjects namely (i) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana - 05 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa - 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra - 05 seats (iv) Panchakarma - 05 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely to Bagamar Seva Samiti's Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Gajendergad Tq. Ron, Distt. Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0083) inspection of your College was conducted on 01.02.2024 & 02.02.2024 in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG BAMS Course and 20 Seats of PG Course in 04 subjects namely (i) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana 05 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra 05 seats (iv) Panchakarma 05 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education regulation, 2022, "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016" provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020, and relevant Regulations there under.

- 3. Thereafter, the assessment report of the academic year 2024-25 was placed in the 99th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 26.07.2024. Board discussed and decided to issue conditional permission to the college after receiving the penalty imposed on the college in the academic session 2023-24 with regard to appointing physically absent but present only on-paper teachers.
- 4. Further, the Board is in receipt of a letter vide Ref. No. B.M.J/AMC/2024-25/275 dated 21.08.2024 from Bagamar Seva Samiti's Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Gajendergad Tq. Ron, Distt. Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0083) mentioning the payment details of the balance Monetary Penalty of rupees Twenty Five lakh (Rs 25,00,000/-). Vide Transaction Id. No. J122025873 dated 21.08.2024 via State Bank of India, Gajendragad Branch, Karnataka.
- 5. Hence, as per the decision taken in the 99th Board Meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, Conditional Permission is granted to Bagamar Seva Samiti's Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Gajendergad Tq. Ron, Distt. Gadag-582114, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0083) with 60 seats in UG BAMS Course and 20 Seats of PG Course in 04 subjects namely (i) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana 05 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa 05 seats (iii) Shalya Tantra 05 seats (iv) Panchakarma 05 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020. Subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements:-
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats and 15 % of post-graduate seats with 20 seats in 04 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of Permission for the academic session 2025-26:-
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 - iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
- 9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating

Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2025-26.
